\*\*This is a check list of the **basic** components needed for each visual arts course. The following courses are examples of Visual Arts courses: Ceramics 1, Ceramics 2, Drawing, Painting, Introduction to 3D Art, Introduction to 2D Art, Advanced 3D Art, Advanced 2D Art, Digital Design, Digital Photography, Fiber Arts, Sculpture, and Printmaking.
